# **Potential projects/activities:**

- Serving in Jim Se Bos township
   (prepare and serve meals, lead kids activities, discover what life is like living in a township)
- Volunteering at the Oceanview Care Centre
   (assist in teaching and caring for children ages 3 to 6)
- Worship Developing a Worship life style (learning from other cultures)
- \* Building maintenance/physical labor at ORC or one of our partner ministries.
- \* Spiritual Rhythms (Prayer, Sabbath, Journaling, Silence and living the Word)

### **Dates and Costs:**

- \* The dates of these trips can vary depending on the participants schedule and the availability of Oceans Retreat Center.
- The trip will be limited to 10 people depending on the itinerary.
- The cost of the trip is around \$3000 depending on airfare.
- The length of the trip can vary, but generally run around 14 days.



# **Pre-trip needs:**

- \* Valid passport for 6 months after our return date.
- \* The following immunizations and shots are recommended: Updated immunizations, Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, updated tetanus and typhoid.

- \* **Table Mountain** Whether you hike up, or ride the tram, the views of the coastal region of Cape Town are breathtaking.

- Robben Island President Nelson Mandela was imprisoned here for 18 years. The island is a unique symbol of "the triumph of the human spirit over adversity, suffering and injustice".
